Captain's List

Dom Perignon Brut Champagne, Epernay, France 2012 \$405

After a welcoming opening, the wine quickly becomes vibrant and then literally explodes with a surge of effervescence and tonicity. Focused by acidic and bitter notes, the finish brings a penetrating tautness marked by ginger, tobacco, and toasted accents.

Veuve Clicquot "La Grande Dame" Brut Champagne, Reims, France 2015 \$315

This solar vintage, while elegant and precise, offers fresh minerality with light floral notes of jasmine and acacia on the nose, which evolve into fruity notes of pear and clementine.

Louis Latour "Corton-Charlemagne" Grand Cru Chardonnay, Côte d'Or, France 2020 \$425

First pour reveals a beautiful pale golden hue. Round and generous, its nose reveals aromas of grilled almonds and Madagascar vanilla. It presents a beautiful amplitude in the mouth, exposing melted woody and mineral finale. Very good persistence and elegant finish.

Mollydooker "Velvet Glove" Shiraz, McLaren Vale, Australia 2018 \$450

Dense, dark and brooding in the glass, the 2018 vintage is complex and opulent. Black plum, blueberries and roasted coffee intermingle with anise in its lifted fragrance. A supremely smooth mouthfeel like molten chocolate accentuates with precise balance of structure and expresses deep flavors of berries, while liquorice and allspice linger on the palate.

Caymus "Special Selection" Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa 2017 \$300

Lush and very forward, with velvety textured waves of cassis, mulled plum and blackberry reduction mixed with flashes of mocha and roasted vanilla. Long with seamless structure letting the fruit play out. For the hedonist crowd.

Shafer "Hillside Select" Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa 2018 \$575

Frankly ripe but well-focused, with blackberry and creamed boysenberry notes flowing through atop a polished structure, while cocoa and black licorice frame the palate. A subtle hint of sassafras lingers on the finish, adding an enjoyable textural nuance.

Opus One Bordeaux Red Blend, Napa 2019 \$600

Elegantly styled, despite some serious heft, this offers a mix of alluring mulberry, griotte and cassis notes bearing a gently mulled edge, while flashes of applewood, sweet bay leaf and red tea flicker along the edges. Very refined in feel, with seamless structure extending to the finish so the fruit can linger.

Stags Leap "The Leap" Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa 2017 \$300

Cabernet Sauvignon from this century-old 240 acre estate in the Stags Leap district of Napa Valley is planted on well drained volcanic soil. Glossy tannins and velvety texture accentuate the wine's poise as violets and sweet earth bathe in black-fruit creaminess. A perfect example of what a wine can be from this region.

Continuum "100th Harvest" Red Blend, Napa 2019 \$500

Blackberries, dark wet soil and black currents. Graphite, too. Pure fruit, full-bodied with superbly polished fine tannins that draw you down through the center of palate. Extremely layered and the texture is so curated, giving wonderful persistence. True plushness and fine, velvety texture.

Chateau Pichon Baron Bordeaux Grand Cru, Pauillac, France 2018 \$375

A very polished and pure expression of Pauillac. As charming and vibrant as the cassis, cherry preserve, and blackberry reduction are, they have a latent saturated feel. And then there is a serious network of iron girders supporting it all, along with sweet tobacco, floral and worn cedar accents.

Justin "Isosceles" Red Blend, Paso Robles 2018 \$275

Savory nose with a leafy character, reminiscent of green olives. Tobacco leaf, currants, red chili pepper and umami too. Generous and broad on the palate with a medium to full body, sweet tannins and berries. Savory and pretty long.
